Arthur B. Corwin, PE, has dedicated over 42 years to a career in engineering and construction. In his current role as President at Railroad Construction Company, Inc. He was involved in some of the country's most significant infrastructure projects including the "Big Dig" in Boston and the 2nd Avenue Subway and the #7 Subway Extension in NYC.

His most memorable project was the recovery and reconstruction of the World Trade Center in NYC after 9/11.

Mr. Corwin was named the 2015 Alumni of the Year at a dinner held by the State University of New York in Farmingdale and he was honored at the annual Moles Dinner with the Member Award in 2016.
